# **GUIDE TO ACE CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS**

You can present your students with the opportunity to earn a Year 10 General or Academic Certificate and a Year 12 General or Academic Certificate. The ACE Certificate **Requirements** sheets outline, which subjects (required and optional) are necessary for certificate achievement.

PACE 1085 is the commencement of certificate requirements. A series of 12 completed PACEs normally constitutes one credit toward graduation. Each certificate requires a specific number of credits. It will take between 2 and 3 years to meet the Year 10 requirements, and a further 2 years to complete Year 12 requirements, depending upon the student's ability and workload.

### **YEAR 10 CONSIDERATIONS** (Students in Years 8, 9 and 10)

When a student commences PACE 1085 in Maths or English, it is necessary to consider expanding from the 5 core subjects (Maths, English, Social Studies, Science, Word Building), and Literature, to include Bible and Elective courses. It would be wise to have the student commence either New Testament Survey or Typing at this point.

**Maths** - Students considering tertiary entrance (certain TAFE courses or University) should choose a course of study which majors in maths. This is because they will sit for the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT), 33% of which is a maths test. We recommend that such students choose Algebra I followed by a combination of Geometry and Algebra II. See notes on the Year 12 certificate requirements.

Business Maths is helpful for those who wish to delay Algebra I until they are more mature. It is also a helpful subject for students entering the workforce or TAFE courses after graduation.

General Business is a subject, which is mainly a reading subject. There are no mathematical calculations required of the student in this subject. It is a useful overview of business principles, and may be chosen in the elective category for a Year 10 certificate.

Students with low mathematical aptitude can gain a Year 10 General Certificate by choosing Maths Overview followed by Business Maths or General Business.

**Social Studies** - Complete World Geography or World History, then complete Australian History.

**Core Subjects** - For a Year 10 **Academic** Certificate, students are required to complete 2 courses in each core subject, plus an additional course in two of the following:

Maths, English, Social Studies, Science.

For example, a student considering a future in maths/science/technical areas would be advised to complete extra Maths and Science courses. Students considering the humanities field may choose English and Social Studies as extra credits. Algebra I is compulsory for a Year 10 Academic Certificate.

### **YEAR 12 CONSIDERATIONS** (Students in years 11 and 12)

**Maths** - The single maths credit required is a minimum. We recommend that extra maths courses be taken by students anticipating further study at the tertiary level. They ought to choose advanced mathematical subjects for the following reasons:

- 1. Tertiary prerequisite knowledge. Some university courses assume that a student has prior learning in that subject area before commencing the course.
- 2. SAT. One third of the SAT is a maths test. It is used to determine whether a student is able to achieve at a tertiary institution or not.

**English** - Students who anticipate humanities studies at tertiary level may wish to include one of these:

- English 1121 1132 (American Literature),
- English 1133 1144 (British Literature) or
- English Composition II (1-10).

choices as their English course and the other as an elective.

**Social Studies** - Please refer to the Scope and Sequence for a description of each course. Some are explained in the High School Electives and some are in the College (Senior Secondary) Electives section of the curriculum Scope and Sequence.

**Science** - Students anticipating technical studies at the tertiary level should choose Chemistry and Physics.

### **General Considerations**

It is important that your student does not just meet the minimum certificate requirements but aspires to gaining maximum preparation for his/her life's calling.

It is advisable to choose the more academic subjects, which will provide more options for your student upon graduation. However, if your student has difficulties, contact an ACHS academic advisor for further advice.

Please do not underestimate the student's ability or the education you are providing. Bring your child to his/her potential. Home-educated graduates have in the past shown themselves to be successful in the tertiary, business and industrial spheres. Your child can succeed in God's plan in life.

- 4. Any compilation of 12 PACEs below 1097 to remediate a student's numeracy skills e.g. Fractions, decimals, percentages, etc., which is approved by ACHS, prior to commencement.
- 5. Any compilation of 12 English PACEs below 1108 to remediate a student's English skills, which is approved, by ACHS, prior to commencement. In most cases this will contain Grammar 1-6, but may, in exceptions, contain fewer or no Grammar PACEs.
- 6. Any compilation of 12 Maths PACEs above 1096 e.g. Algebra I 1097, 1098, 1099, 1100, Geometry 1109, 1110, 1118, Algebra II 1121
- 7. SAT 1 Maths Preparation for students who **do not** wish to study the Senior Maths Course, but would like to prepare for the SAT 1 Test. After completing Algebra I (1097-1108), complete Geometry 1109, 1110, 1113, 1114, 1116, 1117, 1120; & Algebra II 1122, 1123, 1125, 1128, 1130. This course earns one credit entitled "SAT 1 Maths Preparation".
- 8. Students who wish to complete the Senior Maths course are advised to complete the following PACEs as preparation **after** completing Algebra I (1097-1108): Geometry 1109-1114; 1117-1119 & Algebra II 1126, 1129, 1130. This course earns one credit entitled "Senior Maths Prep."
- 9. Senior Maths I & II are one Maths B course, designed for entrance into Science, Maths and Engineering degree courses.

### **Notes**

- 1. Students anticipating tertiary studies should check with their tertiary admissions website for subject pre-requisites of their tertiary course.
- 2. Substitutions of other courses and credit for courses completed e.g. TAFE courses will be considered. Please apply for permission before commencing the course. Ask ACHS for further information and an application form. The number of credits allocated will be determined by course length, duration, rigor and assessment standards. Typically a maximum of 2 credits granted.
- 3. A minimum of eight credits must be ACE courses.
- 4. Students anticipating University studies should complete additional subjects in Maths and their chosen area. Working through The Official Guide to SAT book will help to further prepare a student to sit the SAT. This Guide is available from the Orders Department.
- 5. SAT Maths Preparation for students who **do not** wish to study the Senior Maths Course, but would like to prepare for the SAT Test. After completing Algebra I (1097-1108), complete Geometry – 1109, 1110, 1113, 1114, 1116, 1117, 1120; & Algebra II – 1122, 1123, 1125, 1128, 1130.
- 6. Students who wish to complete the Senior Maths course are advised to complete the following PACEs as preparation after completing Algebra I (1097-1108): Geometry - 1109-1114; 1117-1119 & Algebra II - 1126, 1129, 1130. Pre-req. Algebra I
- Senior Maths I & II are one Maths B course, designed for entrance into Science, Maths and Engineering degree courses.
